Campus Bildung Gesundheit bids farewell to the Klybeck site

Successful interim use coming to an end

After two years, Campus Bildung Gesundheit is leaving the Klybeck site. The temporary solution provided an ideal learning and working environment for around 2,500 students and trainees while Spengler Park in Münchenstein was being converted.

In close collaboration with Campus Building Gesundheit, the Klybeck site was adapted to meet the school's needs in the summer of 2021. Building WKL-132 on Unterer Rheinweg, building WKL-147 by the Dreirosenbrücke bridge and building WKL-121 were shored up to make sure they could meet the demands of an educational institution. In addition, building WKL-620 was converted for use as a space for movement. This enabled teaching to continue at the Klybeck site for two years, to the utmost satisfaction of everyone involved.

Using the Klybeck site as a temporary home for Campus Bildung Gesundheit was, in the view of the people responsible, a logical use for the location and one that significantly invigorated the site. Further interim uses are currently being considered. Rhystadt AG's other usable buildings are virtually all rented out, some of them for the long term. This includes both "traditional" and cultural interim uses by businesses in the creative sector and also new long-term uses, such as the Basel caterer Ryago and their recently opened "Klybeck 610" events platform.

Rhystadt wishes the students at Campus Bildung Gesundheit continued success as they return to Spengler Park in Münchenstein and all the best for the future!
